ALL SAINTS' DAY NOVENA – BEGIN 23 OCTOBER - 1 NOVEMBER

According to Catholic teaching, there are three states of the Church: the Church Militant, the Church Penitent, and the Church Triumphant. We are the Church Militant because we are still living our earthly life and are active in spiritual warfare on Earth. The Church Penitent are those who are in Purgatory who are being purified so as to be fit for entering Heaven. The Church Triumphant are those who are already in Heaven. It is this last group that we celebrate on All Saints' Day and whose intercession we regularly seek in these novenas, because they are the ones who already see God face-to-face.

About All Saints' Day

All Saints' Day is celebrated on November 1, the day after Halloween, which is no coincidence since Halloween is All Hallows' Eve (i.e., the eve of All Saints' Day). Each recognized saint has his or her own feast day, but on All Saints' Day, we celebrate all the saints together, both those who are known and those who are unknown by us who are still on Earth. As we celebrate all those who are in Heaven, let us remember that we are called to one day join them.

2025-2026 ANNUAL PARISH CENSUS – Each individual/family living within the Parish, who attends Saint Joseph Parish Masses on a weekly basis is to register in order to maintain their active membership; one may only be registered in one Parish at a time; so if you have moved in from another parish, you need to let them know that you have moved to Saint Joseph Parish; or vice versa. Membership on the parish roll determines who may receive Sacraments, who may receive permission to act as godparents, sponsors or witnesses for Sacraments, be enrolled in religious education classes, have the right to a Funeral Mass, cost of burial within the parish cemetery, who may exercise ministries within the parish, permission to use the parish facilities and the costs associated with the use of our facilities, etc. The Parish is responsible to the Diocese and to Rome with regard to who are registered/active members. The Pastor of the Parish also has ministerial responsibilities for the good of the souls of Parishioners which does not carry over to non-parishioners. In order to be considered an Active Parishioner, one must keep the Precepts of the Roman Catholic Church to the best of their ability: 1) Attend Mass and observe days of obligation; 2) Confess your sins at least once a year; 3) Receive the Eucharist at least once a year during the Easter season; 4) Observe the days of fasting and abstinence established by the Church; 5) Help to provide for the needs of the Church according to your ability.

CENSO PARROQUIAL ANUAL 2025-2026 – Cada persona o familia que reside en la Parroquia y asiste semanalmente a las misas de la Parroquia de San José debe registrarse para mantener su membresía activa. Solo se puede estar registrado en una parroquia a la vez, por lo que si se ha mudado de otra parroquia, debe informarles que se ha mudado a la Parroquia de San José; o viceversa. La membresía en el registro parroquial determina quién puede recibir los sacramentos, quién puede recibir permiso para actuar como padrinos, madrinan o testigos de los sacramentos, quién puede inscribirse en clases de educación religiosa, quién tiene derecho a una misa fúnebre, el costo del entierro en el cementerio parroquial, quién puede ejercer ministerios dentro de la parroquia, el permiso para usar las instalaciones parroquiales y los costos asociados con el uso de nuestras instalaciones, etc. La Parroquia es responsable ante la Diócesis y Roma con respecto a quiénes son miembros registrados/activos. El párroco también tiene responsabilidades ministeriales para el bien de los feligreses, las cuales no se extienden a quienes no son feligreses. Para ser considerado feligrés activo, debe observar los preceptos de la Iglesia Católica Romana lo mejor posible: 1) Asistir a misa y observar los días de precepto; 2) Confesar sus pecados al menos una vez al año; 3) Recibir la Eucaristía al menos una vez al año durante la Pascua; 4) Observar los días de ayuno y abstinencia establecidos por la Iglesia; 5) Ayudar a cubrir las necesidades de la Iglesia según sus posibilidades.

33 DAYS TO EUCHARISTIC GLORY – We will begin this daily pilgrimage together as a Parish on Wednesday, 22 October, and end with the Consecration to the Most Holy Eucharist after the Masses on the Weekend of 22-23 November, The Solemnity of Jesus Christ the King of the Universe. There are books available on the Table by the Saint Joseph Statue; suggested donation is \$10/book. What it is: A 33-day consecration to Jesus in the Eucharist, helping you surrender to God's will and transform your life. How to participate: Read the daily reflection, complete the journal questions, and consider joining a small group. Some resources and reflections will be posted weekly.
