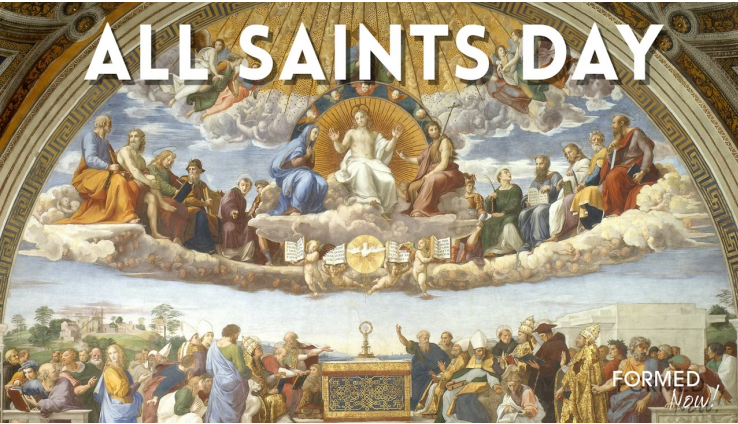

2025-2026 ANNUAL PARISH CENSUS – Each individual/family living within the Parish, who attends Saint Joseph Parish Masses on a weekly basis is to register in order to maintain their active membership; one may only be registered in one Parish at a time; so if you have moved in from another parish, you need to let them know that you have moved to Saint Joseph Parish; or vice versa. Membership on the parish roll determines who may receive Sacraments, who may receive permission to act as godparents, sponsors or witnesses for Sacraments, be enrolled in religious education classes, have the right to a Funeral Mass, cost of burial within the parish cemetery, who may exercise ministries within the parish, permission to use the parish facilities and the costs associated with the use of our facilities, etc. The Parish is responsible to the Diocese and to Rome with regard to who are registered/active members. The Pastor of the Parish also has ministerial responsibilities for the good of the souls of Parishioners which does not carry over to non-parishioners. In order to be considered an Active Parishioner, one must keep the Precepts of the Roman Catholic Church to the best of their ability: 1) Attend Mass and observe days of obligation; 2) Confess your sins at least once a year; 3) Receive the Eucharist at least once a year during the Easter season; 4) Observe the days of fasting and abstinence established by the Church; 5) Help to provide for the needs of the Church according to your ability.

CENSO PARROQUIAL ANUAL 2025-2026 – Cada persona o familia que reside en la Parroquia y asiste semanalmente a las misas de la Parroquia de San José debe registrarse para mantener su membresía activa. Solo se puede estar registrado en una parroquia a la vez, por lo que si se ha mudado de otra parroquia, debe informarles que se ha mudado a la Parroquia de San José; o viceversa. La membresía en el registro parroquial determina quién puede recibir los sacramentos, quién puede recibir permiso para actuar como padrinos, madrinan o testigos de los sacramentos, quién puede inscribirse en clases de educación religiosa, quién tiene derecho a una misa fúnebre, el costo del entierro en el cementerio parroquial, quién puede ejercer ministerios dentro de la parroquia, el permiso para usar las instalaciones parroquiales y los costos asociados con el uso de nuestras instalaciones, etc. La Parroquia es responsable ante la Diócesis y Roma con respecto a quiénes son miembros registrados/activos. El párroco también tiene responsabilidades ministeriales para el bien de los feligreses, las cuales no se extienden a quienes no son feligreses. Para ser considerado feligrés activo, debe observar los preceptos de la Iglesia Católica Romana lo mejor posible: 1) Asistir a misa y observar los días de precepto; 2) Confesar sus pecados al menos una vez al año; 3) Recibir la Eucaristía al menos una vez al año durante la Pascua; 4) Observar los días de ayuno y abstinencia establecidos por la Iglesia; 5) Ayudar a cubrir las necesidades de la Iglesia según sus posibilidades.

R. Have mercy on them, O Lord.

Mary, Mother of God, come to their assistance with Your powerful intercession.

Day 2 Woe to me, unhappy being, so many years have I already spent on earth and have earned naught but hell! I give You thanks, O Lord, for granting me time even now to atone for my sins. My good God, I am heartily sorry for having offended You. Send me Your assistance, that I may apply the time yet remaining to me for Your love and service; have compassion on me, and, at the same time, on the holy souls suffering in Purgatory. O Mary, Mother of God, come to their assistance with Your powerful intercession.

Day 3 My God because You are infinite goodness, I love You above all things, and repent with my whole heart of my offenses against You. Grant me the grace of holy perseverance. Have compassion on me, and, at the same, on the holy souls suffering in Purgatory. And You, Mary, Mother of God, come to their assistance with Your powerful intercession.

Day 4 My God because You are infinite goodness, I am sorry with my whole heart for having offended You. I promise to die rather than ever offend You more. Give me holy perseverance; have pity on me, and have pity on those holy souls that burn in the cleansing fire and love You with all their hearts. O Mary, Mother of God, assist them by Your powerful prayers.

Day 5 Woe to me, unhappy being, if You, O Lord, had cast me into hell; for from that dungeon of eternal pain there is no deliverance. I love You above all things, O infinite God and I am sincerely sorry for having offended You again. Grant me

the grace of holy perseverance. Have compassion on me, and, at the same time, on the holy souls suffering in Purgatory. O Mary, Mother of God, come to their assistance with Your powerful intercession.

Day 6 My Divine Redeemer, You died for me on the Cross, and have so often united Yourself with me in Holy Communion, and I have repaid You only with ingratitude. Now, however, I love You above all things, O supreme God; and I am more grieved at my offences against You than at any other evil. I will rather die than offend You again. Grant me the grace of holy perseverance. Have compassion on me, and, at the same time, on the holy souls suffering in Purgatory. Mary, Mother of God, come to their aid with Your powerful intercession.

Day 7 O God, Father of Mercy, satisfy the ardent desire of the holy souls in Purgatory! Send them Your holy Angel to announce to them that You, their Father, are now reconciled with them through the suffering and death of Jesus, and that the moment of their deliverance has arrived.

Day 8 O my God, I also am one of these ungrateful beings, having received so much grace, and yet despised Your love and deserved to be cast into hell. But Your infinite goodness has spared me until now. Therefore, I now love You above all things, and I am heartily sorry for having offended You. I will rather die than ever offend You. Grant me the grace of holy perseverance. Have compassion on me and, at the same time, on the holy souls suffering in Purgatory. Mary, Mother of God, come to their aid with Your powerful intercession.

Day 9 My God, how was it possible that I, for so many years, have borne tranquilly the separation from You and Your holy grace! O infinite Goodness, how long-suffering have You shown Yourself to me! Henceforth, I shall love You above all things. I am deeply sorry for having offended You; I promise rather to die than to again offend You. Grant me the grace of holy perseverance, and do not permit that I should ever again fall into sin. Have compassion on the holy souls in Purgatory. I pray You, moderate their sufferings; shorten the time of their misery; call them soon unto You in heaven, that they may behold You face to face, and forever love You. Mary, Mother of Mercy, come to their aid with Your powerful intercession, and pray for us also who are still living in this world.
